GENERAL PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) Certificate endorsed within the past 10 years.
 - For some BMPs, applicants may also be eligible by working through an Agri-Environmental Group Plan (AEGP), please refer to BMP Guidelines for details.
- Own or control a minimum of 320 acres of farmland in Saskatchewan.
 Intensive operations on less than 320 acres may also be eligible.
- Earn a minimum of \$35,000 of gross farm income in Saskatchewan in the year of application.
- Projects must be completed and claims submitted on or before January 31, 2018.
- You are responsible for obtaining and complying with any permits or approvals required and for incorporating any relevant mitigation measures for your project. Requirements must be met prior to receiving a rebate.

FUNDING:

• \$50,000 is the maximum funding an applicant can receive under Growing Forward 2 for the Farm Stewardship Program.

- am a resident of Saskatchewan at least 18 years of age; an Indian Band whose reserve land is in Saskatchewan; or a Partnership, Co-operative, Corporation, or Communal Organization that carries on business in Saskatchewan and filed an income tax statement in the year prior to application, or for the year application is made that shows, or will show a minimum of \$35,000 of gross income derived from farming in Saskatchewan;
- am the legal occupier of a minimum of 320 acres of land in Saskatchewan or operator of an intensive farming operation and have an Environmental Farm Plan, or am part of an Agri-Environmental Group Plan that has a Statement of Completion endorsed within the past 10 years;
- agree to provide further information, including income tax returns or project records, that the Program may reasonably require and to inform program administration
 of any changes to the application information for the purpose of administering this application;
- consent to and authorize the release of any information to the Ministry relating to my/our business operations from any government ministry, agency, or third party, for the purpose of verifying information and eligibility of this application;
- authorize the Ministry to request information from any federal or provincial government ministry or agency, suppliers or from any third party, to disclose that information to the Ministry, and consent to disclose any information contained in this application or pertaining to payment, to such ministry, agency, or third party, for the purpose of administering the Program;
- consent to and authorize the Ministry to disclose information relating to my application or payment to any review committee that may be established for the purposes
 of this Program, in the event that a review is requested;
- authorize the Ministry, or its designated representatives, to enter the premises identified on the application or any other premises related to the expenditures identified in this application, for the purposes of verifying the eligibility of the application and associated expenditures claimed for rebate;

- agree to provide the Ministry with original receipts if the Program requests them;
- acknowledge that I am responsible for any cost overruns or expenditures in excess of the amounts contributed by the Ministry under the Program;
- understand that there are no issues of liability with respect to the Ministry, or other government agencies, regarding the construction of an approved project. Neither
 the Ministry, nor the Government of Saskatchewan, shall be liable to indemnify the Applicant for any liabilities it incurs in the performance of the work undertaken by
 it in this project. The Applicant shall hold the Minister, the Government of Saskatchewan, and all government employees, agents and representatives, past or
 present, harmless from and against all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, expenses and causes of action, including claims:
 - Arising out of any breach or failure to perform by the Applicant of any of its obligations under this program;
 - Relating to injury (including death) to persons, or loss of or damage to property, arising out of the negligence or wilful misconduct of the Applicant, its contractor, officers, agents or employees; or
 - Arising out of the work undertaken by the Applicant pursuant to this project including, but not limited to, claims for builders' liens, workers' compensation, employment insurance, holidays, back pay or any rates or charges.
- if, in the Minister's opinion, I breach any of the promises or undertakings, terms or conditions of this application, then the Province may require the Applicant to repay all or part of any payments the Applicant received under the Program, in addition to any other recourse the Province may have including, but not limited to, deeming any past, current or future applications ineligible;
